| | Rich and full bodied, yet silky smooth with ripe brambly fruit flavours and hints of dark chocolate and spice. | | |
| 40 | Malbec, Mendoza, Trapiche | Argentina | 19.95 |
| | The Malbec grape is not dissimilar to Merlot, add a splash of spice and you are about there. | | |

Maipo Valley, Nostros | Chile | 19.50 |

| | Don't let the label put you off - this is amazing!
Using Châteauneuf-du-Papes classic 3 red grapes, Shiraz/Cinsault and Mourvèdre, and then softening it with the white grape Viognier, you get structure and ripe tannins.
It is rich and full flavoured with black fruits and subtle spice. | | |
